y^{\prime \prime}-2 y^{\prime}+10 y=0, \quad y(0)=1, \quad y^{\prime}(0)=2 .
$$

2. (20 points) Use the method of reduction of order to find a second solution $y_{2}(x)$ of the differential equation

$$
x^{2} y^{\prime \prime}+2 x y^{\prime}-2 y=0, \quad x>0
$$

knowing that a solution of the above equation is $y_{1}(x)=x$.
3. (20 points) Use the method of undetermined coefficients to find a particular solution $y(x)$ to the inhomogeneous equation

$$
y^{\prime \prime}-2 y^{\prime}+y=x e^{2 x}+4
$$

4. (20 points) Find the recurrence relation for the coefficients $a_{n}$ of the power series expansion $y(x)=\sum_{n=0}^{\infty} a_{n}\left(x-x_{0}\right)^{n}$ centered at $x_{0}=0$ of the solution of the differential equation

$$
\left(2+x^{2}\right) y^{\prime \prime}-x y^{\prime}+4 y=0
$$

You do not need to solve the recurrence relation.
5. (20 points) Find the general solution $y(x)$ of the Euler equation

$$
(x-1)^{2} y^{\prime \prime}+8(x-1) y^{\prime}+12 y=0 .
$$
