What: The Final Exam will cover ALL material for the previous Exams 1 – 4, and in addition, Sections 16.5, 16.6, 16.7 and 16.8.

Practice Materials: Practice Exams 1 – 4 on MyMathLab, and the MML homework for sections 16.5 – 16.8. Additionally, a previous GT Math 2401 exam from Professor Brett Wick has been posted on our class website and on T-Square. You should also look at the quizzes and worksheets throughout the semester.

Important things to be aware of:

- **Bring a Picture ID!** You will be asked to place your Picture ID on your desk before the test, and your TA will be going around the room checking your name against your ID and the class roster.
- **Don't be late!** If you are late for the exam, there will be no extra time given to you in order to complete the exam. You will have from 9:05AM to 9:55AM to complete the test.
