Books: *Thomas' Calculus*, Thomas and Finney. 11th Edition. This will be a reference book for the course. It has been chosen since it is the book used for most other calculus courses at MSU. However, we may use other sources as needed.

Material Covered: Calculus in two and three dimensions: partial derivatives, gradients, multiple integrals, vector calculus. We will cover at least the material in Math 234, but will cover it at a higher level.

Students are responsible for any information stated in class during their absence. Homework: Homework will be assigned daily and posted on the website. Time will be made available to discuss the homework problems in class. I will randomly collect some of the homework each week.
